



Early on that first Easter morning, the women came to the tomb expecting grief. What they found instead was an empty grave and an angel's question: *"Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen!"* (Luke 24:5–6).

The resurrection of Jesus is more than just the centerpiece of our faith — it's the beginning of a new reality. The stone was rolled away, not just from Jesus' tomb, but from everything that tries to keep us stuck: fear, despair, sin, even death itself.

This Easter, I see signs that God is still rolling stones away in the life of our church.

New people are finding their way into our community. Longtime members are stepping into new roles of leadership and service. People are finding healing. Prayers are being answered. Joy is rising again — not because life is easy, but because Christ is alive. Easter reminds us that resurrection is not just something we celebrate once a year — it's something we live.

Every time we forgive, every time we serve, every time we welcome someone in Jesus' name, we are practicing resurrection. We are saying, with our lives, that love is stronger than death.

So let me ask you: What stone is God rolling away in your life right now? What new thing might the Spirit be doing in you? In your family? In this church?

Let's keep walking together, as Easter people — with hearts open, eyes wide, and hands ready.




