



BACK TO SCHOOL, BACK TO LIFE: THE HOLY TASK OF LIFELONG LEARNING



It's August again—the familiar rituals return: sharpened pencils, notebooks, fresh nervous excitement, new backpacks, and perhaps new schools. As summer fades, our thoughts turn naturally to going back to school. But school isn't just for students. As Christians, we are lifelong learners, always

called deeper into the mysteries of God.

In Romans 12:2, Paul writes, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." The Christian life is a continual education in Christlikeness. The Greek word Paul uses for "transformed" is metamorphoō, from which we derive "metamorphosis." It's the process of becoming more than we currently are, not through human strength alone, but through openness to God's ongoing teaching and renewal.

Early Methodists took seriously John Wesley's belief that Christian formation requires lifelong learning. Wesley himself was a voracious reader, constantly urging Methodists toward spiritual growth through disciplined study and engagement with Scripture, tradition, reason, and experience.

But lifelong learning isn't merely an individual pursuit; it's

communal. We grow best in dialogue with one another, as we learn from each other's insights, wisdom, and experiences. Proverbs 27:17 famously reminds us, "As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another." In our church community, each of us is both teacher and student. Our journey of learning in Christ is enriched by the diverse gifts, backgrounds, and questions we bring to our shared life.

This August, let's renew our commitment not just to sending our children back to school, but to embracing our own schooling in discipleship. Read a book that challenges you. Join a Bible study, Sunday School class, or small group. Seek conversation with someone whose perspective is different from your own. Ask the Holy Spirit to renew your mind and enlarge your heart.

In God's school, graduation is never the goal—transformation is. May we always remain eager, curious, and humble learners, open to the lifelong curriculum of grace.



The event is open to all people. We'll be discussing the issues of anxiety, depression, chronic illness, divorce, grief & loneliness, substance misuse, and trauma. Participants will hear from licensed clinical therapists, spend time in peer support guided by a clinician and spiritual director, and have a time of silent reflection.

No one should suffer with mental health diseases alone. Through this event we are trying to build a community that can become a place of hospitality and welcome to those dealing with mental health issues, where there is no judgment or stigma, and by which all people can find support as we walk alongside each other while we deal with mental health issues.

We will also provide childcare for those attending (limited availability for infant – 5th Grade) for a \$5 registration fee. This fee will cover lunch.
