





Dear Friends,

This coming Sunday, December 4, is the grand finale to our 200th Anniversary celebration. I hope you will join us at one of our services and our free Celebration Lunch at 12:00pm. We will also be revealing our Bicentennial Exhibit of our

church's history. You won't want to miss it; it is truly amazing! It was December 7, 1821, that the Rev. Dr. Alexander Talley was appointed to the frontier town of Pensacola which had just become an American territory. He was sent here to make disciples of Jesus Christ in a place that desperately needed to know of the love of Christ. One of the things that is remarkable about Talley's ministry is how he felt called to also study and practice medicine in order to fulfill his calling.

Like John Wesley, whose most famous book was a medical work, The Primitive Physick, Dr. Talley saw the good news of Jesus Christ as something that is holistic – composing of the body, mind, and spirit. This understanding of God's mission in Jesus Christ was evident in Talley's work here in Pensacola and his work in the Choctaw Nation. Accompanying the Choctaw on the Trail of Tears to Oklahoma, he offered a Christian witness that will be remembered for the ages.

This vision of holistic ministry for body, mind, and spirit is alive and well in our Methodist sense of mission today. This Sunday let us journey back to that same place of beginning. We find ourselves in a somewhat similar situation as Talley did 200 years ago. Our community desperately needs to know of the saving love of Jesus and needs that same holistic healing that God offers in Christ. Let us in our day, step out in faith like Talley and ask God to do it again as we prepare for the next 200 years of ministry here in Pensacola.

The rest of the month, I invite you to join us for our many Advent activities. You can read all about them in this newsletter. And join us on Christmas Eve at one of our four services – bring your family and friends and celebrate the birth of our Lord!
