Wednesday, February 1—Luke: A Transformed World

- B. Anonymous Authorship, but because of the "we passages" in Acts—historically connected to Luke, Paul's travel companion. Col 4:14, 2 Tim 4:11 Phil 1:24
- C. With the Acts of the Apostles, it is part of a two volume set. Comprising 27.5% of the NT (more than Paul).
- D. To Theophilus—"Lover of God"
- E. Written in Greek for a gentile audience—"Kingdom of God"—High literary quality. (Genealogy from Adam)
- F. Likely from Rome
- G. Orderly account Luke 1:1-4
