Dear friends,

"If I don't have love, I am nothing" (1 Cor. 13:2). We are living in unusually polarized and divisive times. With the 2024 election approaching, we are witnessing increased conflict and the breakdown of community. At First Church, we believe that God has

#### **BEULAH CHURCH PLANT: CORE GROUP MEETING**


