There is an Episcopal church in South Carolina located on the beach. For the season of Lent, they decided to place three crosses in the front yard and drape them in purple. The local Chamber of Commerce called and said, "Would you

please consider taking down the crosses, we understand what you are trying to do and everything and we don't disagree, but this is Spring Break season, our busiest, we have lots of tourists in town to visit the beach. We think that the crosses are sending the wrong message. The crosses are kind of depressing. We want something a bit more upbeat. More spring oriented. More about life." The Chamber could not have been more wrong. The season of Lent and the cross itself are about life. In fact, the word "lent" is an old Germanic word for spring. Despite the fact that Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, as we face our own mortality, and it ends with Good Friday, commemorating the death of Jesus,

it is all about life. We believe that real life comes through death. When we "die to ourselves" we really start to live. Through the death of Jesus, we find new and abundant life.

We will be seeking out this new life in Christ each Wednesday in the season of Lent. We have brought back our special Lenten services at 6:00pm, with speakers from across the Alabama-West Florida Conference. I hope that you will join us for all our special Lenten offerings. Come and find new life in Christ—*Lent* means Spring.

Dear Friends,

After the 40-day season of Lent comes the 50-day season of Easter. It is the most important season of the year. This year, I believe that God is calling our church to participate in "The Great 50 Day Challenge." This is a grassroots initiative that I began in 2016 while serving in Port St. Joe. After a difficult period in the life of the church, I believed that God was calling that congregation to receive 50 new members during the Great Fifty Days of Easter. That number was more than they had received in any previous year. But, on Easter, I announced the challenge and the goal was met by week three. In the end, 98 people joined the church! It was a game changer! Since that experience more than 30 churches have participated in the challenge. Last year, with 29 churches participating, there were 791 new members added!

This year, First Church is answering the call and taking the challenge. We are asking all of our members to invite people to church during Lent and Easter and to help welcome fifty new people into the life of our church. We will have people joining starting on Easter Sunday, April 9, all the way through Pentecost, May 28. Easter is a season to grow in our faith and to grow our church. Let us all take the 50 Day Challenge and find new life in Christ.
