Dear Friends,

Over the last few years, our church has faced unprecedented challenges with the pandemic and social discord. In biblical language, we would define this period as one of wilderness, in which we've felt "stuck" and searching for direction.

However, we are now entering a new era of our history, and I believe that God is calling us to move FORWARD. There is the great scene in Exodus 14 where God tells Moses while leading the people through the wilderness, "Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to move forward!" Our wilderness period is ending, and God is calling us to step out in faith.

We know that God has been faithful to us in our past. The theme for our bicentennial celebration is from the old hymn, "Forward Through the Ages." God has been our guide and guardian throughout the generations here in Pensacola, and now the God who has been faithful to us over the last 200 years will be faithful to lead us forward yet again. FORWARD – that is our stewardship theme for this year (our first Annual Stewardship Campaign since 2019). While the last few years have been difficult financially for our church, now is a time to move FORWARD. And we are asking all our members to pray and answer God's call to move FORWARD with us.

On Consecration Sunday, November 13, we will be filling out our Estimate of Giving Cards, and you have the opportunity to discern what you plan to give in 2023. This process is how we set our budget and make our plans for ministry for the coming year.



The history of First United Methodist Church Pensacola, FL dates back to 1821, when a mission was established by the Mississippi Conference and the Reverend Alexander Talley was appointed as missionary to Pensacola. The mission began by holding meetings in the courthouse and the old theater of Pensacola. In the 200 years since we have had three church buildings, more than 50 pastors, and we have been the home to many thousands of worshipers. Our theme for our bicentennial celebration is "Forward Through the Ages." God has done great things in this community and in the world through our congregation in the last 200 years, and in the month of November we will take a look back and remember God's faithfulness to his people. Then on Sunday, December 4 we will share in a big Bicentennial Celebration just before our 201st Birthday!
