"My Grandmother Baughn was my first teacher of the importance of family and community and serving others. She always opened her home, had something on the stove in case someone was hungry and could sit for hours at her dining room table and listen

intensely while friends and family members shared their news and ate a bowl of freshly cooked greens and cornbread. She attended two churches – one that was right next door to her house – and she had several Bibles. I remember spending the night and waking up to the smell of bacon and finding her sitting at that same seat at her dining room table reading her Bible. She was one of my first examples of faithfulness and service". - Lisa Bond

"I love tea. I start every morning with a cup of Irish Breakfast tea with cream and sugar. When I think back to when I was introduced to tea, I think of my Big Grandma. Big Grandma was my father's mother. She was called Big Grandma because we thought she was so tall (in reality she might have been 5' 6"). Big Grandma lived a block away from our home so we visited often. When we were at her house, we would snuggle on her couch. She would show

me all kinds of things, like how to crochet using a pencil. It was on that couch that she would let me sip from her tea cup. Something about wrapping my hands around a warm mug of tea while sitting on my couch always brings me back to the simpler times I sat with my Big Grandma". - Denise Van Atta



"I grew up moving around the country as a military brat so spending time with my grandparents in the summer was always a special time for our family. My Grandma McClellan was a hard worker, would give you the shirt off her back, loved to cook for her family and loved her bible. She always made sure everyone had a favorite food on the table so nobody went hungry. My Grandpa McClellan was a disabled World War II veteran who loved his family, living out in the country and growing a garden. Grandma and Grandpa did not have a big house, new cars or much in their bank account but they always found a way to give back to their community. Grandma volunteered in the church nursery. Grandpa delivered meals on wheels.



They had servant's hearts. I cherish my memories of volunteering with them, learning to drive Grandpa's truck on the country roads, shucking peas, canning vegetables, making homemade ice cream, and snuggling up with them to watch westerns. I thank God for them and for leading me to serve senior adults". - **Jennifer Piver**
